



Come to “The City of Eternal Spring”: Trujillo

Here are six good reasons why:

Trujillo, capital of La Libertad Region, is located on the north coast of Peru, at the banks of the Moche River, a few Km from the Pacific Ocean (Aproximately 560 Km from Lima, 8 hours by bus). It is the third largest city in Peru with about 811,979 inhabitants. The airport is 10.5 Km from Trujillo, in the Huanchaco district.

We have splendid mansions with typical windows, magnificent churches and temples. There is also a good collection of museums like the Archeological Museum Casinelli with fascinating pieces of the Moche, Mochica, Chimu and Recuay cultures, the Museum of Zoology and the Trujillo Museum, among others.

There are impressive archeological sites just outside the city such as the temples dedicated to the Sun and the Moon, the world’s largest adobe city called Citadel of Chan Chan and the complex of El Brujo.

There are two important festivals in Trujillo, The Marinera Festival in January and the Spring Festival in early October with parades, beauty contests, dancing and open-air concerts.

There are lots of beautiful beaches like Huanchaco and Chicama. Huanchaco is one of the best places in Peru to see the fishermen getting into the sea riding “caballitos de totora” and to enjoy delicious seafood. Chicama is a great beach for surfers.

There is a great shopping mall, Mall Aventura Plaza Trujillo. It has lots of big clothes stores, bookstores, cinemas, banks, drugstores, restaurants, a food court, etc. Trujillo is famous for its shoemaking. There are a lot of cheap and good shoe stores in La Alameda del Calzado in El Porvenir District.


