Peru's fourth largest city, Chiclayo, located on the northern coast is one of the most interesting archeological destinations in the country. A sunny and warm climate with fresh ocean breezes embraces friendly people, beautiful beaches and impressive mountains.

There are daily flights from Lima, Trujillo and Piura as well as regular charter flights from nearby Cajamarca. We also offer regularly schedule buses leaving to and from Trujillo, Cajamarca and Piura on a budget.

Visitors to Chiclayo shouldn't miss out on the most significant archeological discovery: the tomb of the Señor de Sipán, just 35 kms. East of Chiclayo in Huaca Rajada (45 minutes by car). You should also take a tour to "Señor de Sicán" in Batagrande, Pómac, and the Valley of the Pyramids in Túcume. You must vistit the Brünning Museum, with its great collection of archeological pieces of Chimú, Mochica, Chavín and Vicus cultures, the magnificent Museum of the Royal Tombs of Sipán and the National Museum of Sicán.

Chiclayo most beautiful beaches are at Pimentel, a great place to practice water sports such as surfing, and Santa Rosa.

Monsefú, only 15 Km from Chiclayo City, is a town that provides Chiclayo with most of its handcrafts, but you can also buy anything you need in Mercado Modelo located just 5 blocks from the Main Square. It is northern Peru's liviest and largest market. 5.

Chiclayo boasts one of the best cuisines in the country. It's famous for its exquisite "Arroz con Pato" (rice with duck), "Seco de Cabrito" (stew made with goat's meat) and seafood specialties like "Raya Omelet", "Sudado de Chita", etc.

There are also a lot of "Chifas" where you can eat delicious chineese food.

Chiclayo offers a good number of different hotels to choose from in the city and the surrounding area. Prices are affordable and range in quality from luxury hotels to backpacker's hostels. Because Chiclayo is proud of their region's traditional hospitality, all accommodation offers friendly and professional service.

For budget travelers the best way to travel around Chiclayo is by bus.
